

A BRONZE AGE DAGGER FROM PODURI (BACĂU COUNTY)

The article presents a **dagger** recovered in an uncertain stratigraphic context from Poduri-“Dealul Ghindaru”, a site from Eastern Romania with Chalcolithic and **Bronze Age** levels. After the description of the artefact – short, triangular shape, with a rounded plate with three rivets – there are presented few other pieces of similar shape or cast from an alloy containing mainly silver and copper.

The artefact dates from the Early or Middle Bronze Age.

The authors suggest that, due to the fact that other **silver-copper pieces** and triangular daggers were discovered in funeral or ritual context, it is possible that the dagger found at Poduri might originate from a similar destroyed context.
