

Reviewing procedure

Within one month following the closing date for submission, the collected articles are subject to review within the editorial board and beyond. For each of them shall be drawn up assessment reports (minimum two) containing assessments on the compatibility of the article with the journal profile, on the relevance of the topic for the field concerned, on the originality of the research undertaken and on its scientific outcomes, as well as appraisals of the paper's scientific qualities and eventual suggestions regarding improvements needed. Each report concludes with one of the recommendations: 1) acceptance of the article as presented, 2) acceptance of the article after carrying out amendments proposed by reviewer, 3) rejection of the article.

After receiving the reviews, the Editor informs, in writing, the authors of his decision on acceptance or rejection of articles, on the basis of reviewers' comments. The Editor will ask authors to undertake the suggested changes for improvement, within the following two weeks. In case the authors exceed the time allowed for improvement of articles, their publication shall be postponed for the next issue.
